Temporary Protection from Deportation

DACA provides recipients with deferred action, which protects them from being deported or removed from the United States. This protection is valid for a two-year renewable period.

Benefits of DACA

Work Authorization

Approved DACA recipients are granted work authorization, allowing them to seek employment in the United States legally.

Education Opportunities

DACA recipients may have access to instate tuition rates at colleges and universities in some states. However, educational benefits vary depending on state laws and individual institutions.

Social Security Benefits

DACA recipients may be eligible to receive
Social Security benefits, including retirement,
disability, or survivor benefits, depending on
their individual circumstances and
contributions.
